- Nomination by the IWA for the <u>2018 Nobel Peace Prize!</u> The IWA (International Writers and Artists Association) consists of 1900+ writers from 155+ countries and nominates candidates for the Nobel Prizes in Peace, Literature and Science.
- Founder and First President (1980-90), **Society for Poets of Southern NJ** Currently the longest running poetry group in NJ.

- Faleeha Hassan translated his poem, "My Enemy in the Mirror" into Arabic, which was published in December 2014 in a magazine called "28" in Gaza. He is the first Jewish poet who has ever been published in Palestine and yet during the WAR with Israel!
- His poems, "My Enemy in the Mirror" and 'One Less Musician" were translated into Portuguese by Teresinka Pereira, President of the IWA (International Writers Association) and in Greek.
